Now in its third edition, this scientific event is becoming a tradition, a successful tradition. Last year RPD was attended by over 1,500 participants from all over the world; even if the embarrassing problem of COVID was still affecting our lives, the online participation was great.

At this moment, COVID is becoming just a bad memory. Hence, this year's edition will have no limits to participation in person, even though the congress will remain as a hybrid format.

This is why the choice of the venue has been completely different. #RPD23 is held in the heart of the city, in a large congress center that is located just a few meters from Fontana di Trevi, from which it takes its name. In other terms, #RPD23 is "not only science", but an important occasion for discussing the latest scientific advances related to Pain Medicine and Pain Patients' Management, and networking in a stimulating atmosphere of cultural values, surrounded by art, beauty and history.

The scientific program looks amazing. It will be opened by a Plenary Lecture on the impact of scientific research on the patients' management. The speaker, Prof. Anthony Dickenson, is one of the most renowned scientists in the world, who has dedicated all his professional life to the study of Pain Mechanisms. A further session on perioperative management of patients will represent one of the main topics, but also there are proposals on the most advanced approaches to low-back pain. Other proposals are making clear that this year the attentions of the excellent Faculty seem to be mainly focused on the future of Pain Medicine. There are many new perspectives on the horizon, and the most important and promising ones will be presented in Roma. Iatrogenic side effects of pain management will be explored from several points of view. An adequate slot will be given to the diagnostic procedures, especially as a support to invasive management of pain. For this the Paolo Procacci Foundation counts completely on SonoPain and GPS, a group of Colleagues who perceive this as their important mission in educating the new generations of Pain Physicians. One of the rooms of the congress center is dedicated to this important aspect of pain management. Also, we will still have with us the FEDELAT Colleagues, with their educational proposals. The Latino-American Pain Physicians are particularly eager to gain new knowledge in Pain Medicine, and they have chosen #RPD23 as the most promising, best link with European culture on this topic.

The Paolo Procacci Foundation is grateful to all Members of the Scientific and Organizing Committees, the Local Organizing Committee, to the international and extended network that is supporting the initiative represented by the several scientific endorsements received, but especially it is grateful to all the Sponsors. Without their support, the diffusion of the new scientific advancements in Pain Medicine would not be possible.

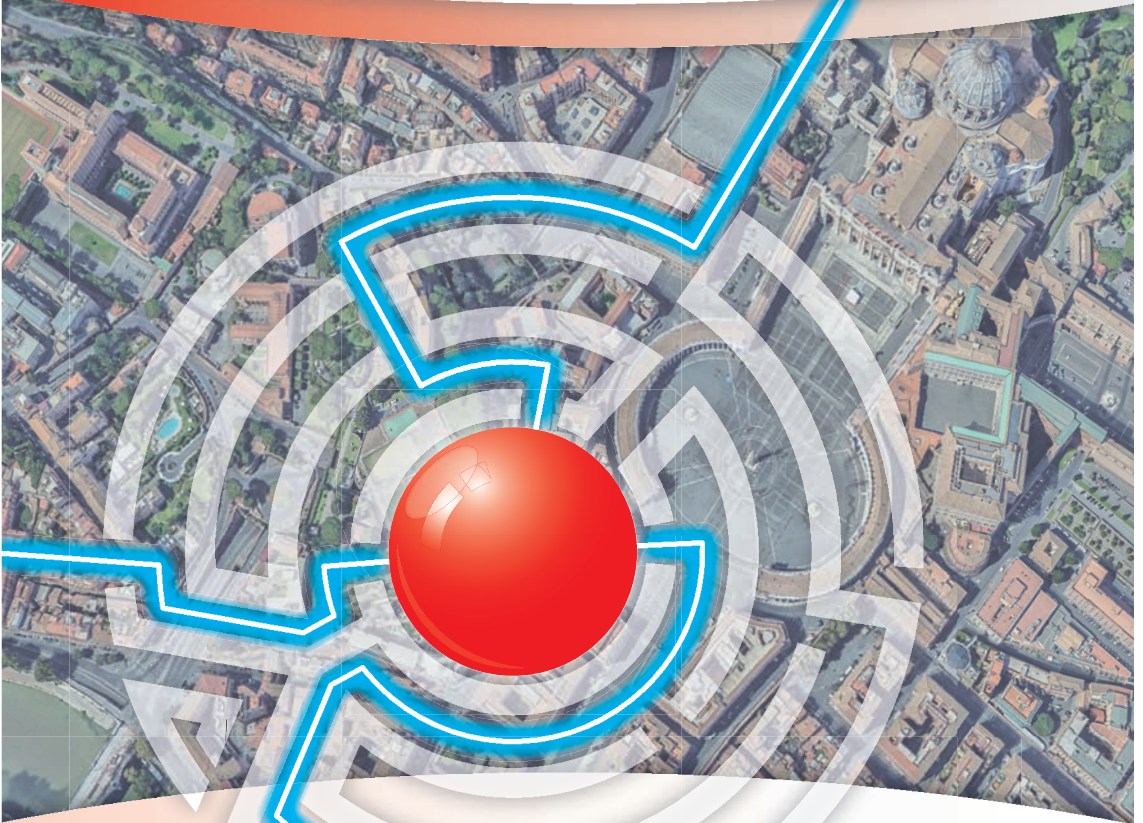
